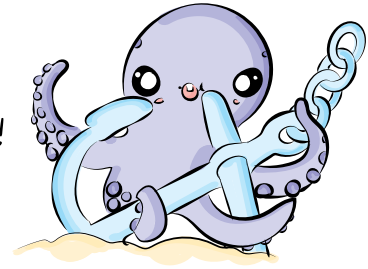


## Lesson Anchor

Birds have beaks to help them get food. We are going to experiment with different types of beaks to see which works best for various types of food. Break into groups and use tools to try to see how many pieces of food you can grab!

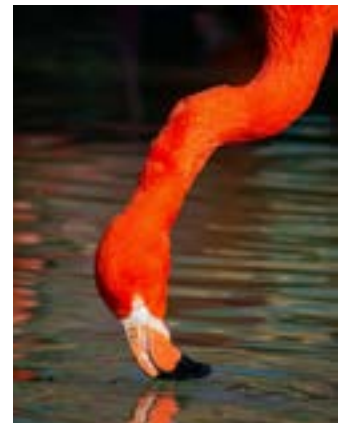
Directions: Spread out large and small items to represent food. Use things like cereal, string, flat pieces of paper and marbles from the Koa crate.

The birds you will be:

Group 1: Bee Eaters (use a pair of tweezers)

Group 2: Spoonbills (use two spoons)

Group 3: Flamingos (use two test tube caps)

Each team should use their beaks to try to get as many pieces of food in their team's container as they can in the set amount of time given by the teacher.
