ABORIGINAL DOT ART TIPS

1- **Show students the movie** as an example for what the students can do. Remember that students can do anything they dream up after they are done watching the movie. Younger students can use the animal outlines to dot from the website if needed.

2- **Go outside** and sit in the shade with your students to do your art project. Painting outside is so fun and really connects students to the art time in a special way. The experience will always be more memorable.
