



Meet Henry the Naked Mole Rat




My name is Henry, and I am a naked mole rat. In fact, I am the only naked mole rat who likes to be in photos!





People like to point and laugh at me because I don't have any fur. But just because I don't have any fur doesn't mean I'm not handsome!





My family is huge, and I love all seventy-five of them. We call our big family group of naked mole rats a "cluster."



My mom is actually the queen, so she's the leader of everyone.


She makes sure each mole rat is helping out and doing their jobs around our home.



We live underground and make tunnels with our long teeth. We need to have tunnels that are big and wide enough that we can all share them.





And then, of course, I can't forget to mention food! Its so much easier to make our lunches and dinners when there's a lot of us to help out.
