She told him how she could help.



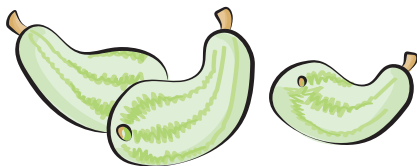
The next time he planted seeds, Aditson planted corn, beans, and squash together. Squash made shade to keep weeds away.





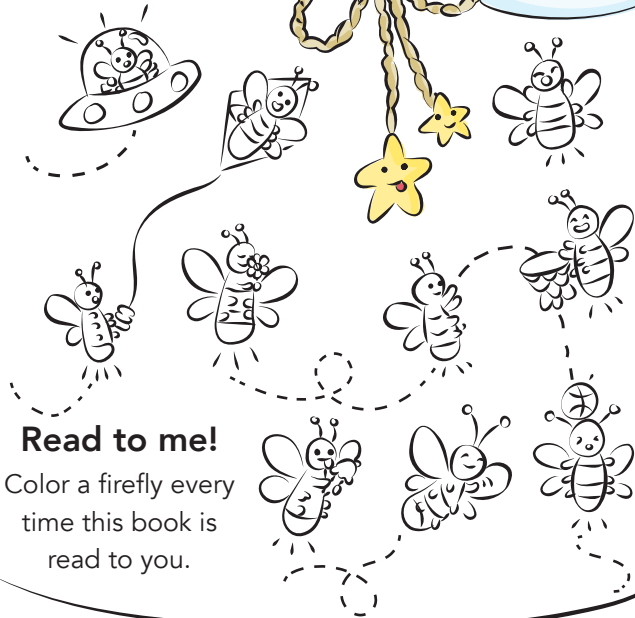
Soon, other farmers were planting the three sisters together. From that day on there was always enough food to eat.

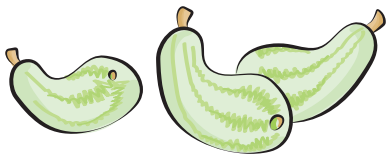
