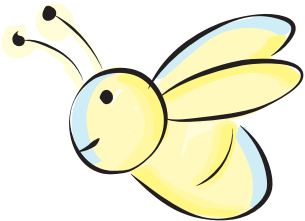
Dear Parent,

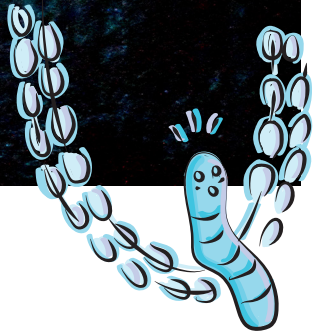

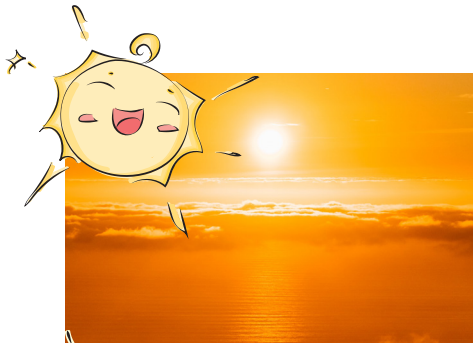
What things make light?

Oh no! Jugnoo falls into the mud. He must learn to fly far.



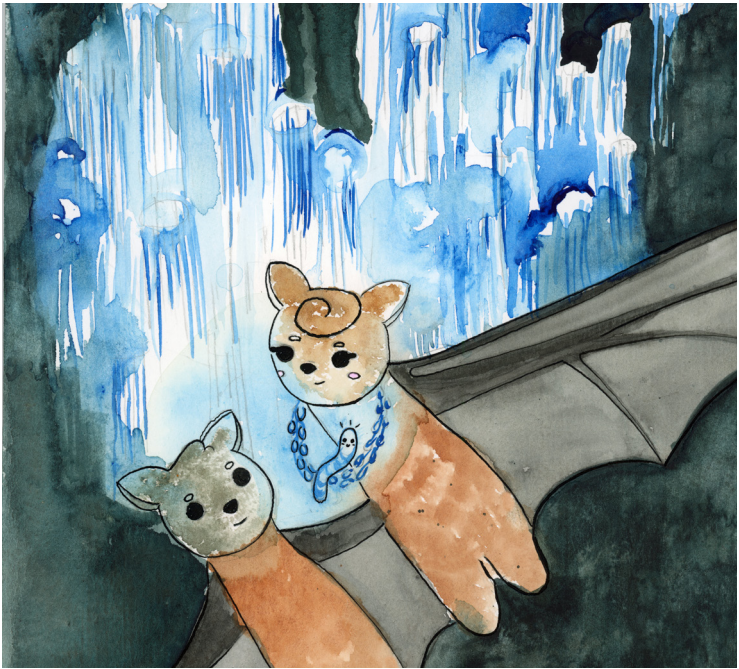
Off Jugnoo flew! Shamaa comes too so

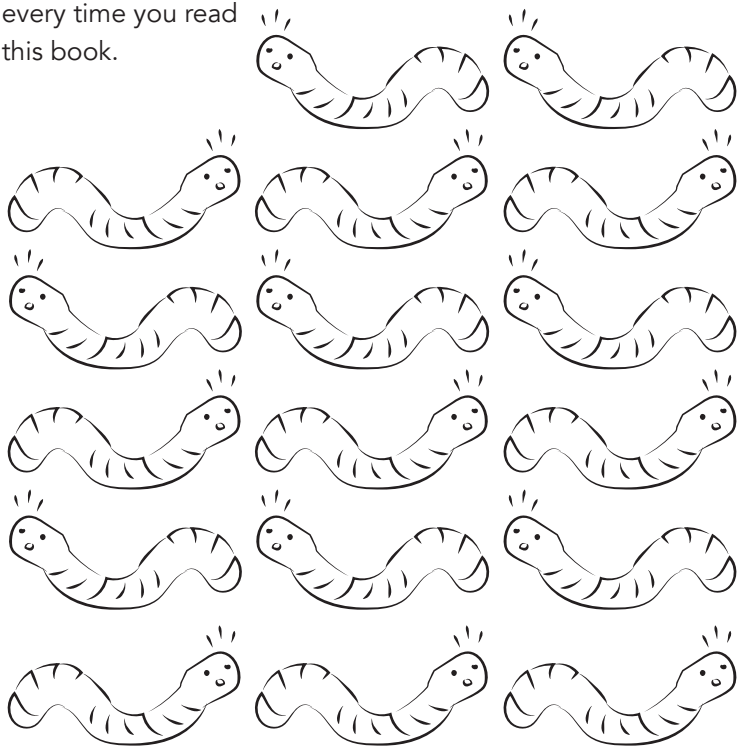
