
Dear Parent,

Reading to your child helps them learn language. When you read to a child, you are exposing them to new words and phrases. This helps them develop their vocabulary and learn how to use language correctly






Nilofer tenía una nueva panadería. Esperaba vender muchas delicias diferentes.

Nilofer estaba triste. Sus delicias horneadas no eran muy buenas. El glaseado se derritió y los pasteles quedaron planos.




Nilofer was sad. Her baked treats were not very good. The frosting was melted and the cakes were flat.

Kiki estaba jugando en la cocina. Ella saltó sobre el mostrador. ¡Oh, no!




Kiki was playing in the kitchen. She jumped up on the counter. Oh no!

Kiki derribó el tazón de Nilofer. Cayó al suelo y se rompió.




Kiki knocked over Nilofer's mixing bowl. It crashed to the ground and broke.

"Tú, ardilla tonta", dijo Nilofer. "Estás loco, pero todavía te amo".




"You silly squirrel," said Nilofer. "You are crazy, but I still love you."

Nilofer usó una bolsa de plástico para limpiar la masa pegajosa. ¡Pero el desastre empeoró!




Nilofer used a plastic bag to wipe the sticky mess. But, the mess just got worse!

Entonces empezó a salir humo del horno. Nilofer no sabía qué hacer.




Then, smoke started coming out of the oven. Nilofer did not know what to do.

No hubo fuego. Nilofer pidió a los bomberos que cerraran la manguera. ¡Ahora todo estaba mojado!




There was no fire. Nilofer asked the firefighters to turn off their hose. Everything was now wet!

La sartén se había derretido y quemado dentro del horno. Había creado un desastre horrible, goteante y lleno de humo.




The pan had melted and burned inside the oven. It had made a horrible, drippy, smoky mess.

Ahora, Nilofer vende deliciosas delicias en su panadería junto a la playa.




Now, Nilofer sells yummy treats at her bakery by the beach.


