






#### Dear Parent,



"Swimming is fun," said the ducks on the lake. What do you think Remi will make?




The stork was so tall that he did not get wet at all. Remi made stilts to walk in the lake.

Now Remi can do many new things, but he was still looking for one more friend.




Then, Remi met whale who helped him play a new way. Remi swam in the water all day.
