
Dear Parent,




This is Samantha sloth.





"¿Como es tu mamá?" preguntó un colibrí. "Ella tiene cabello castaño como yo", dijo Samantha. El pájaro se fue.




"What does your mom look like?" a hummingbird asked. "She has brown hair like me," said Samantha. Off the bird went.


The hummingbird saw Samantha's mommy. She was up in the tree. Samantha's new friends helped Samantha up the tree.

With the help of her friends, Samantha was back with her mommy at last. "Thank you for finding my mommy!" she said with a smile.










