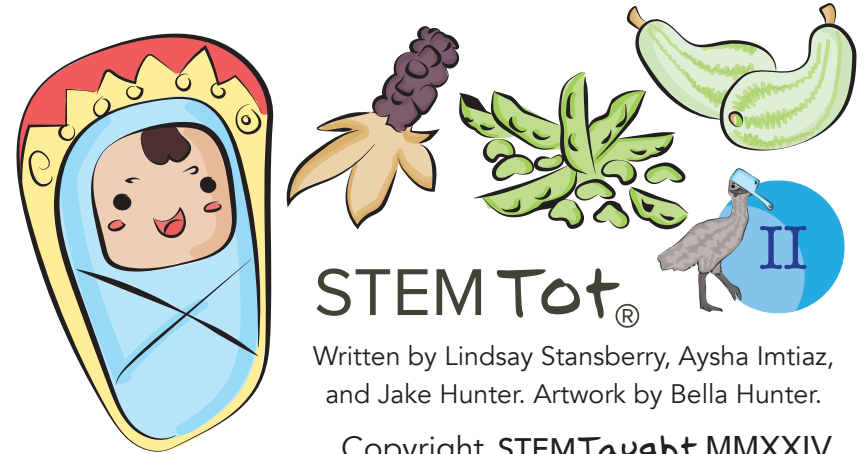




Soon other farmers were planting the three sisters together. From that day on, there was always enough food to eat.
