





Toby Tee is full of good ideas and he likes to have fun!


"That's all for now, Toby! It is time to go shopping," said Mom.

Toby wanted some fun. "Mom, can you go a little faster?" said Toby. He was ready to try his best idea yet.




He would try to slide across the floor. Off he went! But, when it was time to slide, he didn't go far. Toby fell!


"I need better shoes to help me slide!" Toby said.

Toby tested the slipperiness of sandpaper, wood, cardboard, foil, plastic, and banana peels.




Do you know which material Toby used for his shoes?


