




2-LS4-1 Biological Evolution, Unity and Diversity: Make observations of plants and animals to compare the diversity of life in different habitats.



Soral has fun putting bird seed out in the yard to start her experiment.




There are no birds yet. Soral knows she must wait for the birds to find her seeds.

DAY 1




Soral writes a zero in her book because she did not see any birds at her feeder today.



The next day, Soral sees little brown birds eating her seeds. She is excited! She runs to get her journal.


DAY 2

Gophie helps the next day. He sees lots of new birds at the feeder!




The next day, Gophie helps too. He sees lots of new birds at the feeder!

Help Soral be a careful scientist and record the birds that came today.




Oh no! There are ants at the hummingbird feeder. Soral must help the hummingbird so that it can get its food.




Soral cleans the feeder and moves it to a new tree branch where the ants can not find it.

Can you help make a graph of the birds that visited Soral's feeder?







