Luego, Remi conoció a Whale, quien lo ayudó a jugar de una nueva manera. Remi nadó en el agua todo el día.

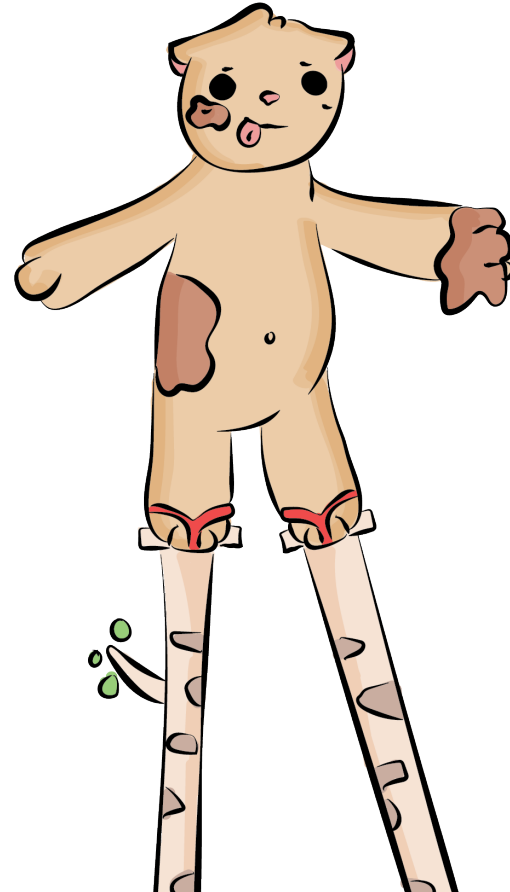


Then, Remi met whale who helped him play a new way. Remi swam in the water all day.

¡A Remi le gustaba jugar con todos los animales y a todos los animales también les gustaban los inventos de Remi!



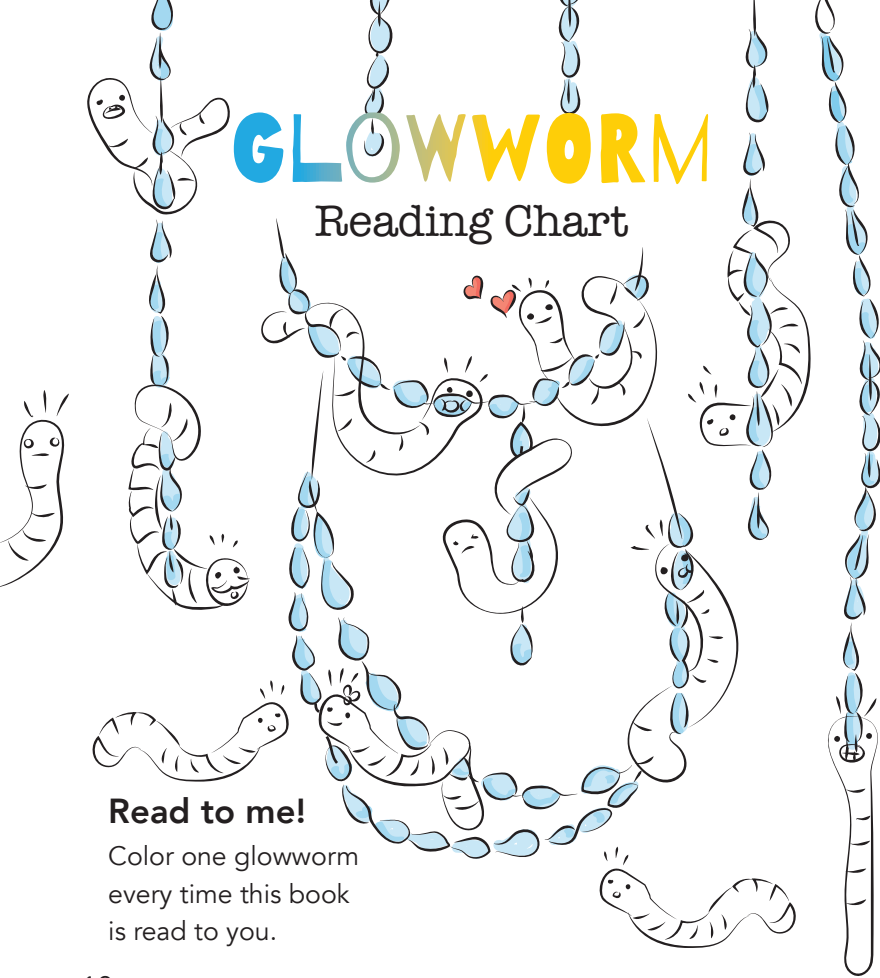

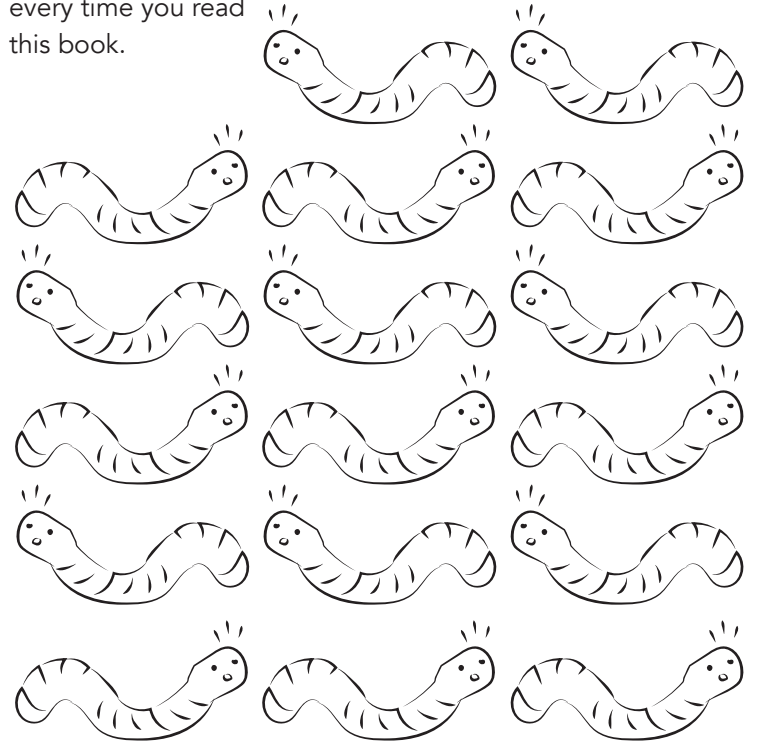

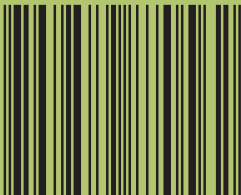
